Cost Breakup of a Typical Indian Wedding

The cost of an Indian wedding can vary greatly depending on various factors such as location, number

of guests, and level of extravagance. However, here is a rough cost breakup of a typical Indian wedding (Refer Figure 1)

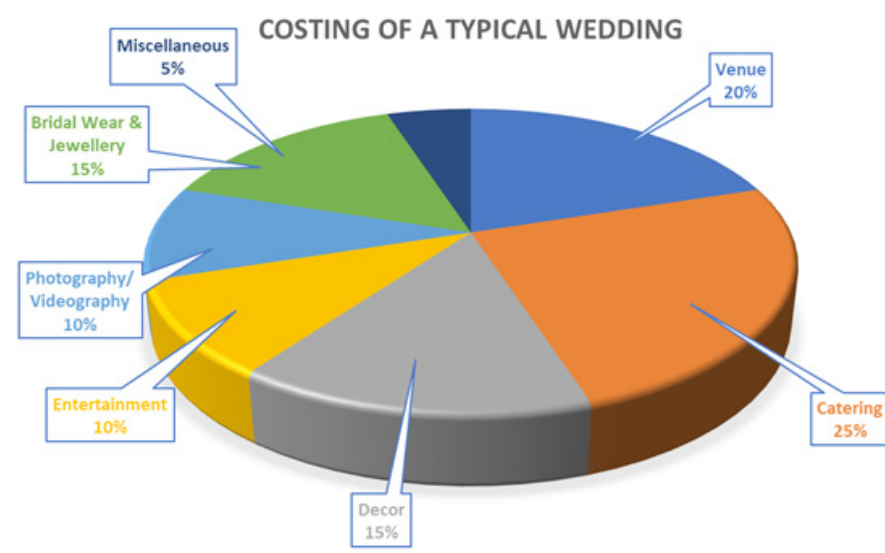


Figure 1.1 – Cost Breakup of a Typical Indian Wedding

1. **Venue - 20-25% of total cost:** The cost of the wedding venue can vary depending on the location, size, and facilities. Popular wedding venues such as banquet halls, hotels, and resorts can cost anywhere from a few lakhs to several crores.
2. **Catering - 20-25% of total cost:** The cost of catering will depend on the number of guests, type of food, and the level of service required. Catering can range from traditional Indian cuisine to fusion or international cuisine.
3. **Decor - 15-20% of total cost:** The cost of wedding decor can vary depending on the level

of extravagance desired. This includes floral arrangements, lighting, furniture, and other decor elements.

4. **Entertainment - 10-15% of total cost:** The cost of entertainment can vary depending on the type of entertainment required, such as live music, DJ, dancers, or performers.
5. **Photography and videography - 10-15% of total cost:** The cost of photography and videography can vary depending on the type of package and the level of coverage desired. This can include pre-wedding shoots, candid photography, and videography.
6. **Bridal wear and Jewellery - 10-15% of total cost:** The cost of bridal wear and jewellery can vary depending on the designer and level of customization required.
7. **Miscellaneous expenses - 5-10% of total cost:** This includes expenses such as transportation, accommodation, invitations, and wedding favours.

It's important to note that these percentages are not set in stone and can vary depending on individual preferences and budgets. The various heads are as outlined in the table 1.2:
